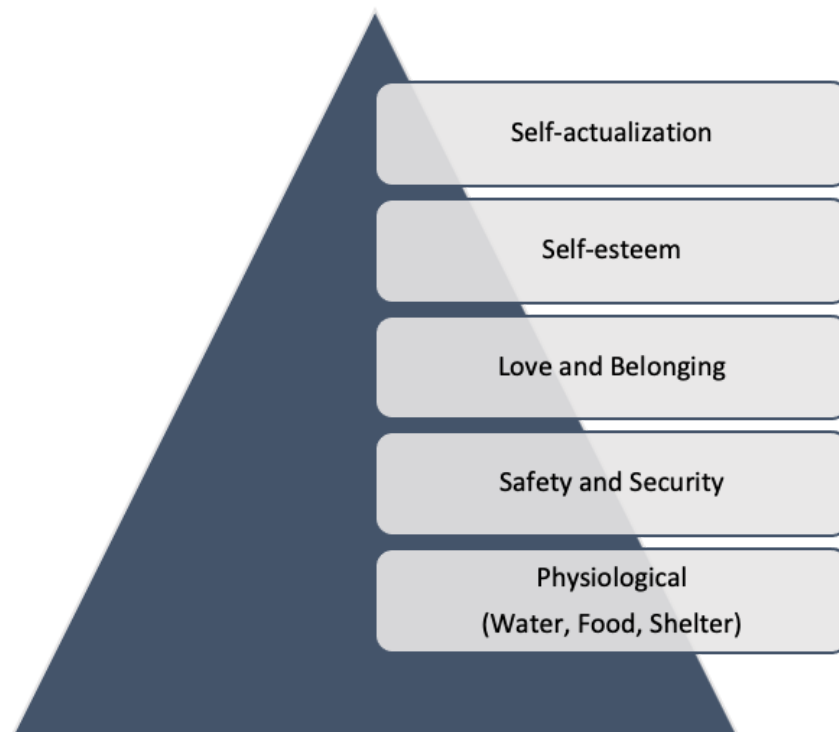

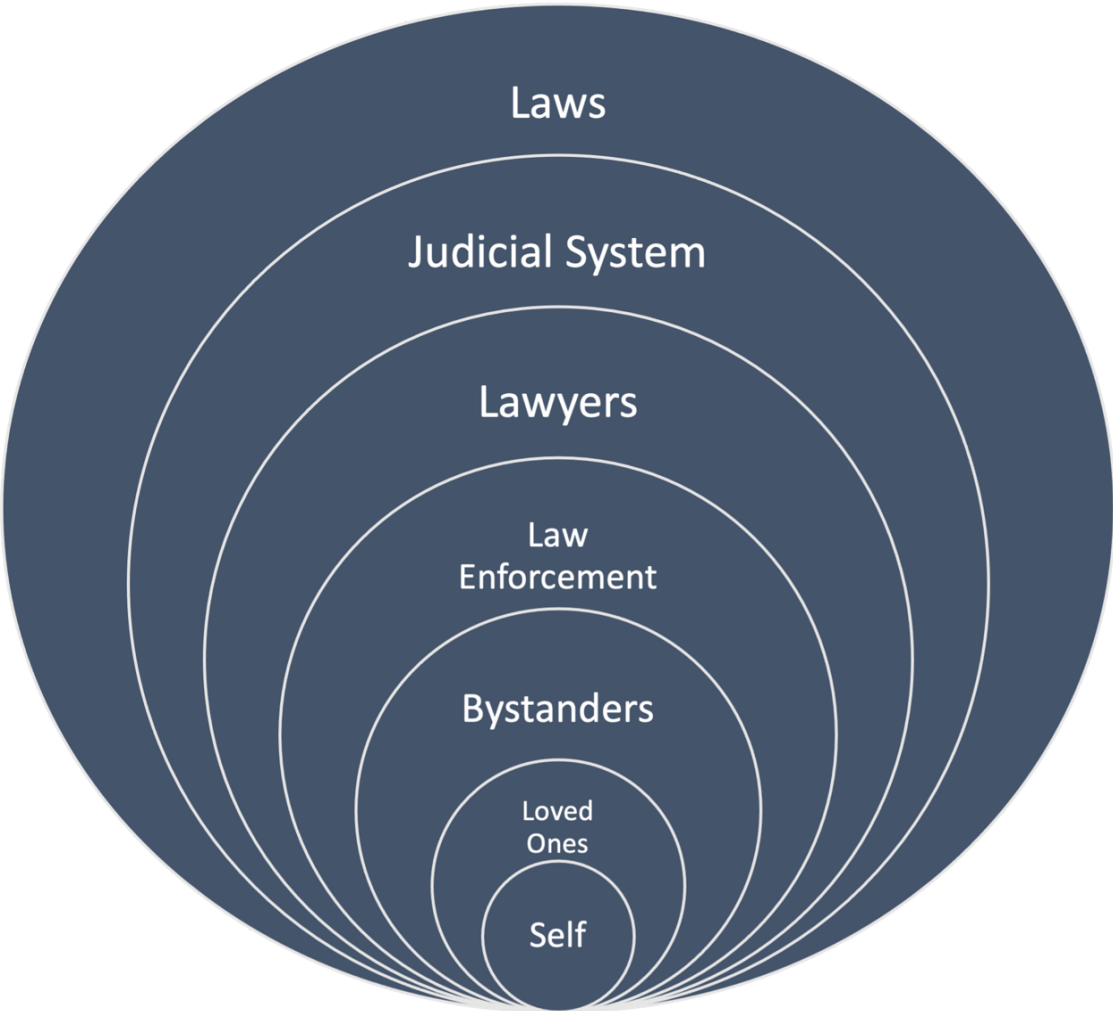

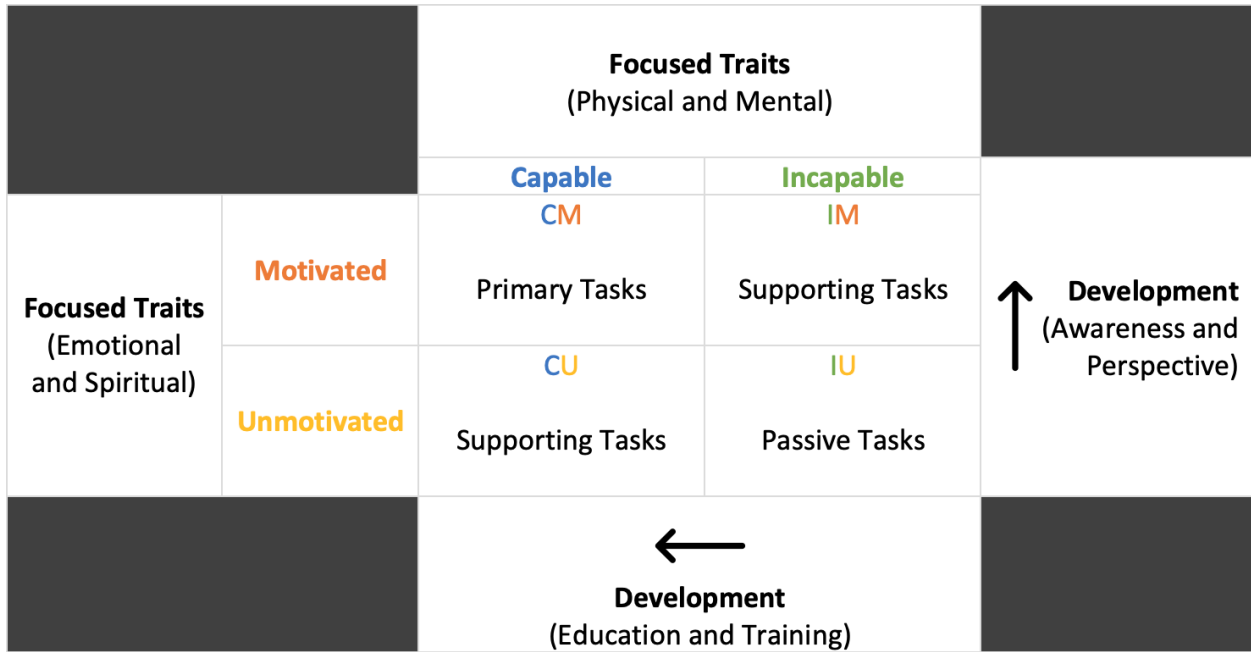

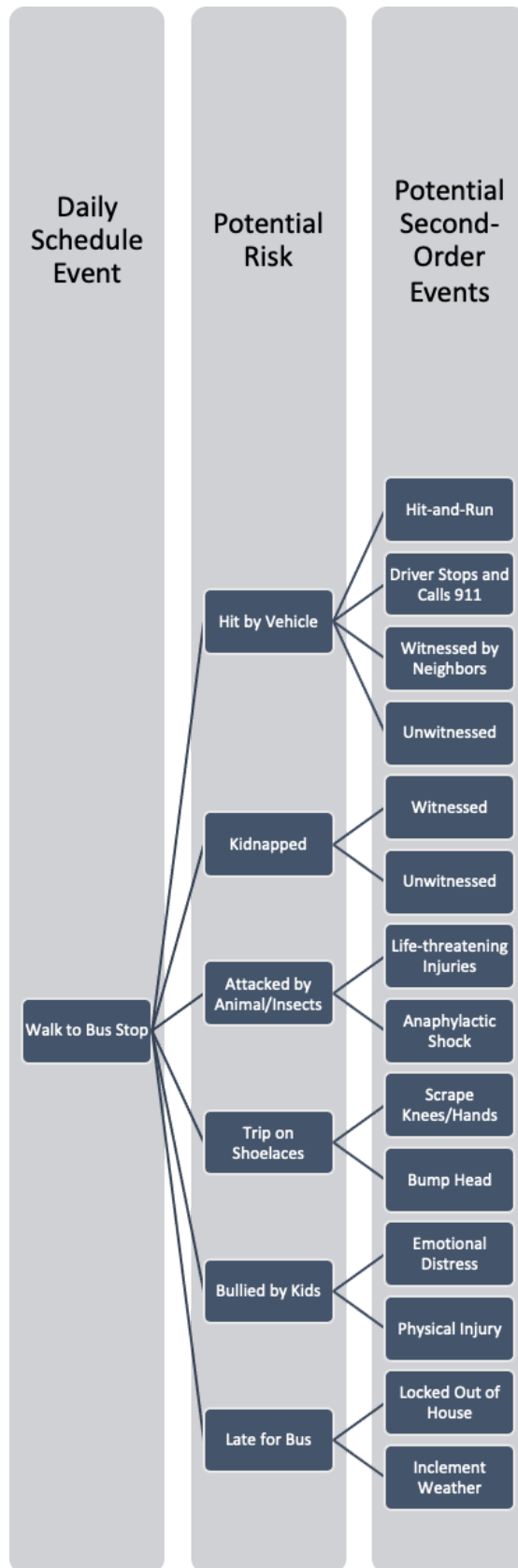

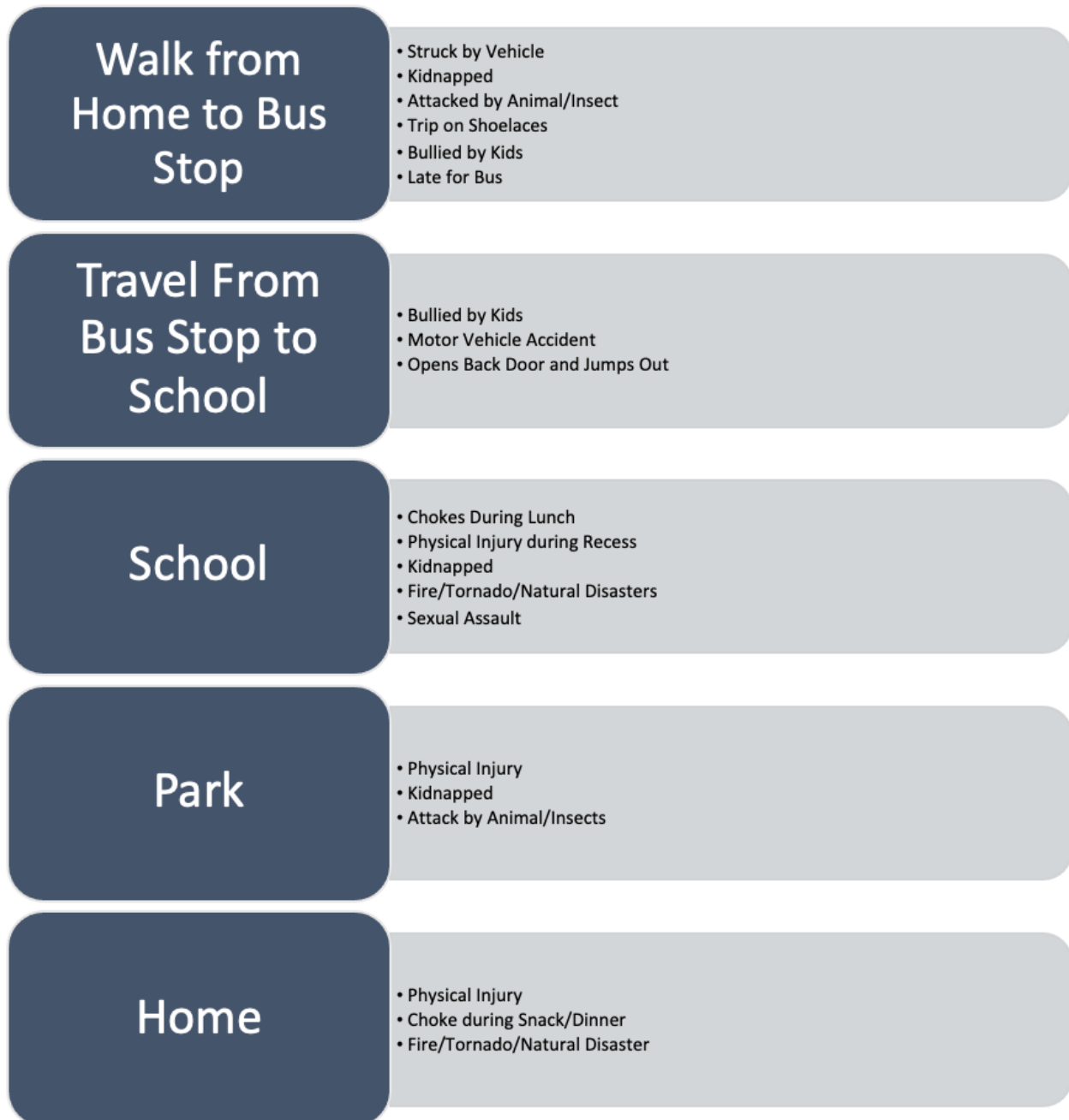

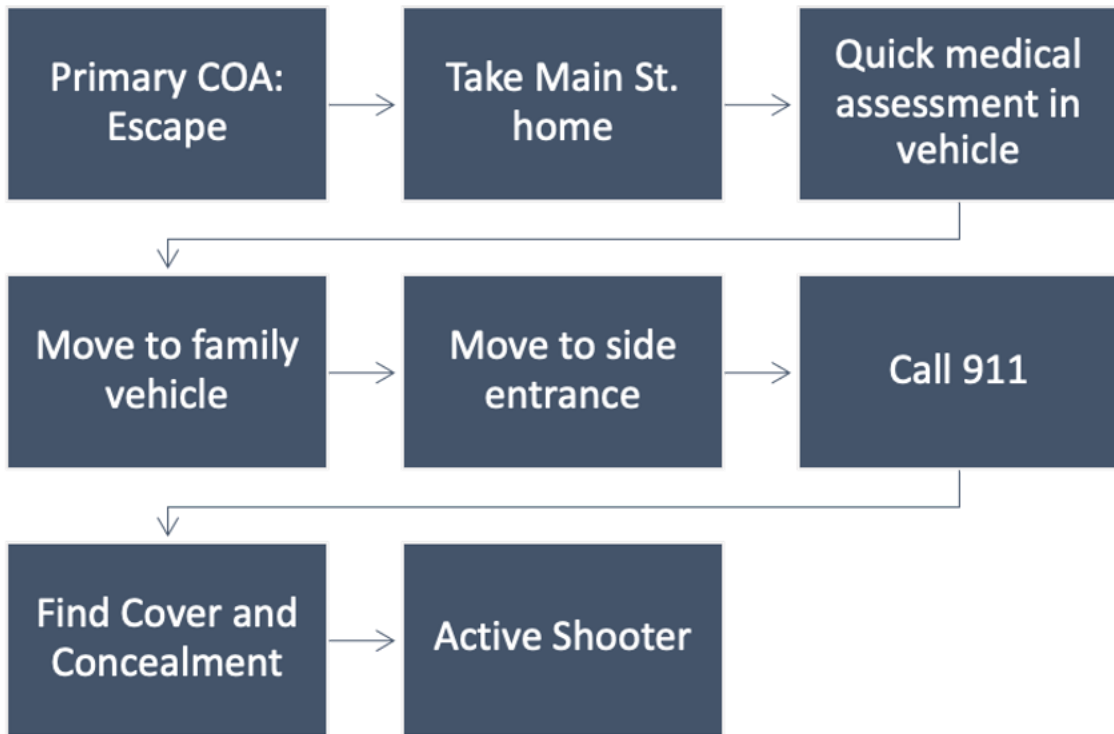

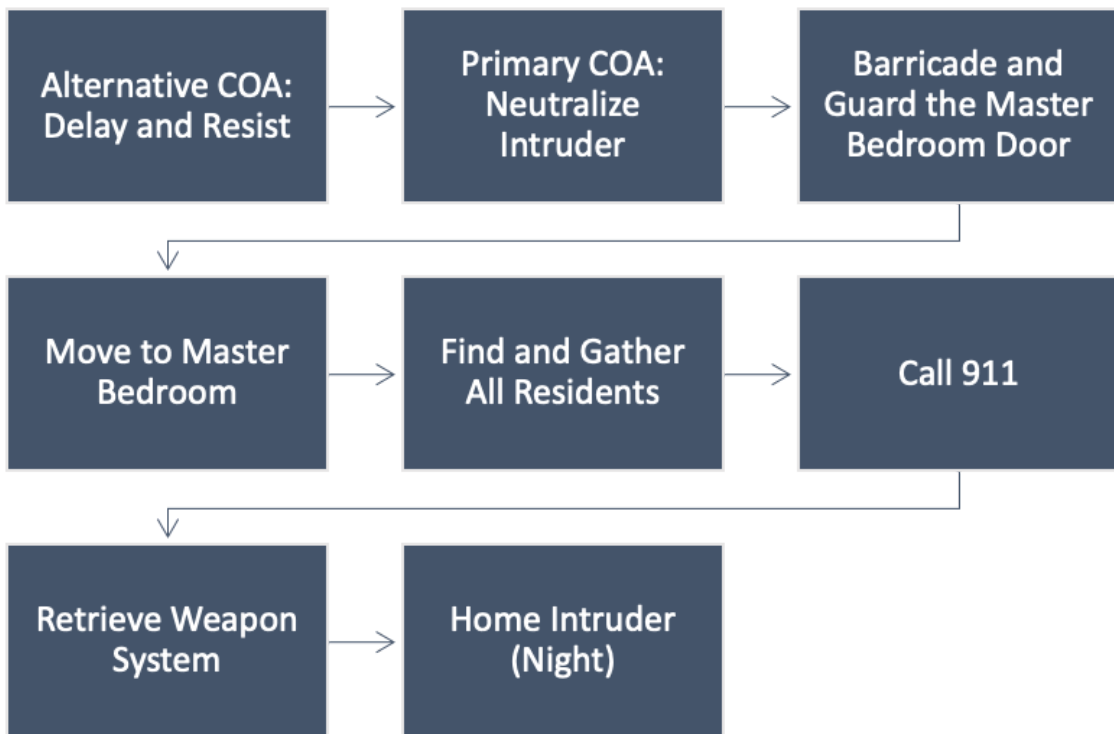

Active Shooter	Best-Case: Shooter will be stopped before initiating the attack.
	Worst-Case: Shooter will target us first.
	Most Likely: Shooter will initiate attack at an entrance to mall.
Find Cover and Concealment	Best-Case: Walls are made of brick and are within ten feet distance of us.
	Worst-Case: Walls are made of dry wall and are outside of fifty foot distance from us.
	Most Likely: Walls are made of brick and are within fifty foot distance from us.
Call 911	Best-Case: Personal cell phone has service and connects with 911.
	Worst-Case: Personal cell phone does not have service and there is no other phone in immediate area.
	Most Likely: Personal cell phone will have service and store will have a landline.
Move to Side Entrance	Best-Case: Side entrance is within a one minute run and unlocked.
	Worst-Case: Side entrance is on the other side of the mall and locked.
	Most Likely: Side entrance is within a two minute run and unlocked.
Move to Family Vehicle	Best-Case: Parking lot is clear of obstacles, vehicles, and pedestrians.
	Worst-Case: Parking lot is crowded by obstacles, vehicles, and pedestrians.
	Most Likely: Parking lot has typical amount of vehicles and pedestrians.
Quick Medical Assessment	Best-Case: No one has an injury.
	Worst-Case: Everyone has a life threatening injury.
	Most Likely: Minor injuries sustained (ex. sprained ankle)
Take Main St. Home	Best-Case: No traffic.
	Worst-Case: Heavy standstill traffic or road closure.
	Most Likely: Moderate traffic.

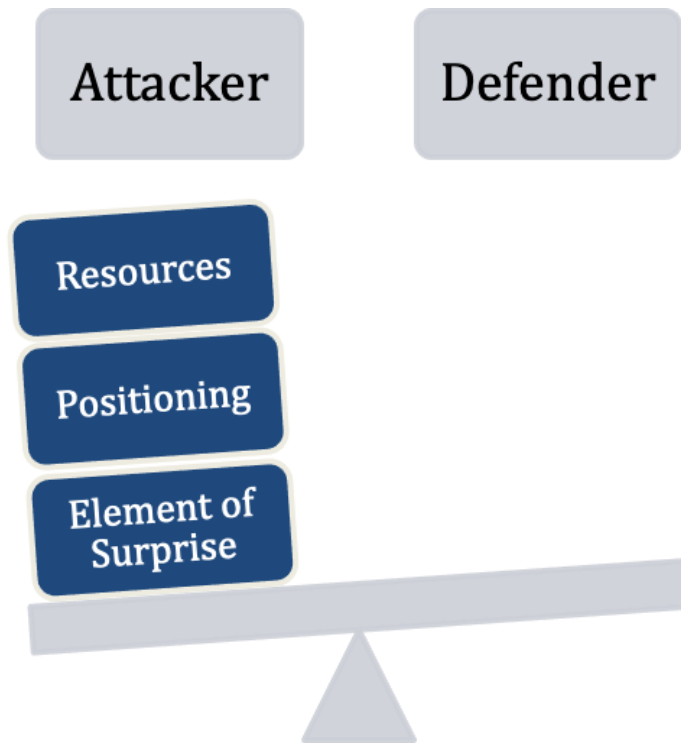

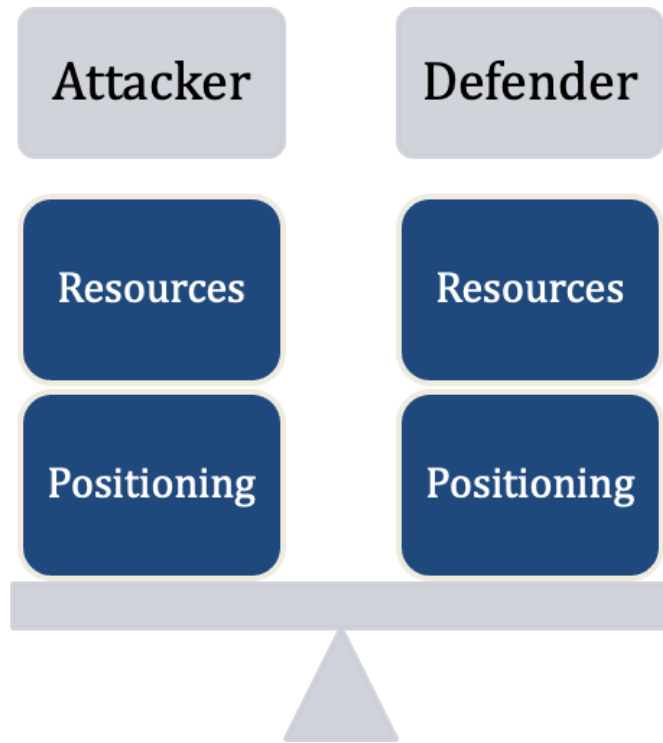
